After closing date, no refunds will be given. All dogs MUST be leashed. Concessions will be available on grounds between 10 am and 2 pm. Dress is casual, but neat and tidy. Half chaps are allowed for CT competitors. ASTM-approved helmets and medical armbands (available from show secretary if needed) must be worn when jumping. Ribbons to 6th place. Management reserves the right to combine, divide or cancel classes as entries warrant.
