BREA Board Meeting Minutes - August 14, 2007

Board Members in attendance: Debby Bright, Kim Smith, Dana Lacy, Ellen Oliver, Linda Oberlender, Bernard Hylton, Susan Icove, Billie Bryant
Other Members in Attendance: Candi Hylton and Margaux Lander

The next meeting will be during the Work Day at Green Hill on Monday, September 3, from 9 AM – 1 PM.

The meeting was called to order at 7:05pm and the July minutes were approved.

Treasurer's Report: The August show incurred costs of \$813.50 and income \$1410.25, leaving a \$596.75 profit.

GHPEC Report: The new entrance is in place. Show managers are reminded to open and close BOTH gates at the start and finish of each show. Ellen is writing GHPEC a letter on behalf of BREA thanking them for the new entrance as they have received some negative comments from dog walkers who have lost their parking places. The water lines to the barns are done and there is a wash bay. If someone is using the first hose, there may not be pressure at the same time at the second as they are on one line. People need to be told to put manure in the dumpster; signs don't seem to be enough.

Membership Report: 1 new member since the last meeting for a total of 94 members.

Equipment Report: The Work Day is Monday, September 3 (Labor Day), from 9 AM – 1 PM, with a pot luck to follow. Dana is going to order a new meter wheel from Bit of Britain ASAP. There are still jump poles that need to be finished striping. We need to see if we can find the instructions for using the dressage arena tool and make several copies (and laminate them?) to make sure they are always accessible for folks setting up dressage arenas.

Newsletter Report: Elyse will continue doing the newsletter for now. Sue Jellum may take over if needed.

Points Report: There are a lot of points coming in. Members need to check the web site frequently to make sure no mistakes are being made. It is much easier to correct the points tally as soon as mistakes are noticed, instead of all at the end of the year.

Education Report: Kiki Osborne will teach at GHPEC on Sunday, August 14. Esters Simms will teach at GHPEC on Sunday, August 26. Contact Susan Ilove to sign up for either lesson day. Susan will contact Lucinda Green to see if the October clinic date can be filled by another group as there are not enough entries as of yet to hold the clinic. Susan will keep everyone posted.

Young Riders Report: The Young Riders who volunteered at the June show will have their Mid-South entries and stabling reimbursed by funds in the BREA Young Riders account.

Southern States Labels Report: Don't forget to send your labels in to Linda if you feed SS feeds.

Horse Shows Report: Billie did a great job for the August show of calling Bastian's BBQ and getting the ribbons organized. DC donated some older Hylton Classic ribbons for use in October.

Teams Report: An email was sent out to prospective team members about getting entries in. They should be to Ellen by August 20 with payment for the full amount made out to BREA. The BREA Adult Team Fund will pay for a tack stall for each of the non-YR teams; this is \$140. Include 2 nights of stabling for right now in your payment, but this is subject to change. There are saddle pads and helmet covers available for team members to use. Jen will have the saddle pads at the Work Day on September 3 in case people would like to try them out first.

After closing date, no refunds will be given. All dogs MUST be leashed. Concessions will be available on grounds between 10 am and 2 pm. Dress is casual, but neat and tidy. Half chaps are allowed for CT and HT competitors. Body protective vests are highly recommended for cross country. ASTM-approved helmets and medical armbands (available from show secretary if needed) must be worn when jumping. Ribbons to 6th place. Management reserves the right to combine, divide or cancel classes as entries warrant.

Directions: Exit 137 off I-81; turn right towards Salem on Wildwood Road. At intersection with Route 11/460, turn right. Go through two lights. At third light, turn left onto Duiguids Lane. Pass first entrance to Green Hill Park and go 1.5 miles to Equestrian Center entrance on right.
