BREA Board Meeting Minutes - Septemeber 3, 2007

The meeting was called to order at 1:30 and the August minutes were not approved as the newsletter had not come out yet.

Treasurer: Treasurer's report will be in the newsletter. Team checks are being deposited.

GHPEC: no report

Equipment: Some bridle numbers are missing. Dana plans to fix others to make a complete set. The recognized horse trials have their own bridle numbers. The new wheel is in from Bit of Britain and is fantastic. Everyone did a great job at the cleanup today and a lot was accomplished.

Newsletter: no report

Points: A discussion ensued regarding the splitting of divisions at our shows. It was decided that divisions with 16 or more entries will be split and classes with 4 or fewer entries will be combined. Beginning with the 2008 prize lists, competitors will enter a division in Jr. or Sr. and then they will be combined if entries warrant. For example, competitors will now enter either Jr. Novice or Sr. Novice depending on whether you are under 18 or 18+. The division from the May HT of Green was split in a way that gave an unfair advantage in points to certain members, therefore points will be doubled for both divisions instead of one. Year End Awards will be given through 6th place as is stated in the points rules end of the year.

BREA brochure status: The board approved for Susan Ilove to move forward with production of brochures. They are complete now.

Half chaps are allowed for CT and HT competitors. Body protective vests are highly recommended for cross country. ASTM-approved helmets and medical armbands (available from show secretary if needed) must be worn when jumping. Ribbons to 6th place. Management reserves the right to combine, divide or cancel classes as entries warrant.
