August 19, 2008

June minutes approved.

Committee Reports:

GHPEC: We will have the cross country course mowed as necessary throughout the year using our Southern States funds.

Treasurer's Report: We currently have \$12,450.86 in checking and savings.

Membership: There are 90 members now.

Equipment: Dana purchased 6 new watches and 6 new radios.

Newsletter: A schedule of horse shows, etc. will be appear in the next newsletter.

Points: no report.

Education: The Lucinda Green clinic will be held Oct. 17-18.

Young Riders: Our August show raised about \$2,500 of profits, compared to approximately \$3,000 raised from our May HT. The young riders who volunteered for at least 6 hours will receive \$150 each from the August show money to be used towards the Lucinda clinic, and another \$1000 of the profits will go towards building additional cross country jumps at Green Hill.

Southern States: The money we collected will be used to pay to have the cross country course at Green Hill mowed.

Horse Shows: The young riders put on August's show.

Teams: Turn forms in.

Volunteer Coordinator: no report.

Awards Banquet: no report.

New Business:

Allocation of funds: Profits from the June CT will go to a clinic for adult BREA members who have completed volunteer hours. Erica will organize the clinic.

Riders may group themselves with 3 or 4 other riders to form a team- best 3 scores count. If you form a team, provide teammates’ names on entry form. If you wish to ride on a team but do not have enough other team members, circle “yes” in the scramble section on the entry form and you will be placed on a team with others. Teams may consist of riders at any level, but must be competing in the same discipline (i.e. all team members riding in the horse trials, or all riding two dressage tests). Teams must pay an additional \$10 fee per team, to be included with the entry of one of the team members. Team members will be awarded team ribbons as well as individual ribbons. Management reserves the right to change this organizational structure as needed to be determined by number and type of entries.

Exit 137 off I-81. Turn right towards Salem on Wildwood Road. At intersection with Route 11/460, turn right. Go through two lights. At third light, turn left onto Duiguide Lane. Cross RR tracks and pass first entrance to Green Hill Park. TRAILERS: Go another mile to the Equestrian Center trailer entrance on your right. CARS: Pass trailer entrance and continue 1/2 mile to car entrance on right.

Late entries MAY be accepted and a \$10 late fee charged, at the Show Secretary’s discretion. Starting times will be emailed to competitors and available by phone on the Thursday before the show.
